Dirty Dozen, Bethesda, 10/3/11, 8:30pm

Monday night the camo clad commandos confronted an unbeaten **Bubba's** bunch battling for the top tier. Standing just upwind of the **Dirty Dozen** stood **The Dead Lois's**, at 4-0, who had given us our only loss, who stood just a half game downwind of **Bubba's** and their 5-0 mark.

We had beaten **Bubba's**, 14-7, in Summer 2011 to go 6-2 and drop them to 5-3, stopping their five game winning streak. This season they had picked up a couple of "new" guys, namely Pat Bradley and a couple of his colorfully rubber shirted friends. While some of our teams have tended to buckle in the presence of rubber shirts, the **Dirty Dozen** does not. We're veterans, used to seeing anything or everything tumble into the other dugout. The overdone Saturday shirts didn't make us bat an eye.

We were Visitors for this monumental mêlée and were most definite not good hosts. Our first two batters sandwiched a fly-out around two singles then the fourth batter made it 1-0, a "Bad, Bad" **Leroy Frazier** single. **Dean Binder** "Clip" was next and busted a deep one for a triple and the two runs put us up 3-0! A fly-out gave us two down, but let Dean score to make it 4-0 before another fly finished us. We held **Bubba's** to a lone run in the bottom of the first, continuing weeks of rock solid defense by the boys in camouflage.

Leading 4-1 to start the second inning, we acted like we hadn't done anything in the first and proceeded to hit the ball afresh. We led off, modestly enough, with a fly-out, but rebounded for three singles and another run to make the score 5-1. Two doubles made it 7-1 and two more singles had us leading 9-1. Another double and single put us up 11-1 before we finally made the second out of the inning. We were not done yet, though, as **Tim** "Quick Draw" **McCoy** added a twelfth run on a two-out single. A walk loaded the bases, but a ground-out finally stopped us, though we'd batted fourteen times, scoring eight brand new runs. **Jeff Montgomery** was on base twice in the inning with a single and a walk. **Bubba's** swallowed a donut in the bottom of two and we held a 12-1 lead after two.

We were good for one run in the top of the third inning then it was **Bubba's** turn to put a big, crooked number on the board, a five-spot that got them back in the game, 13-6 after three. We failed to score in the top of four, but **Bubba's** had another helping of donut, still 13-6, but now after four complete innings.

We scored the only runs in the fifth inning when **Russell Ray** "Dawn Chong" went deep, way over LCF for a one-out, inside-the-park homer and we now led 15-6 after five. We kept on plinking in runs in the top of the sixth, needing insurance with the clock ticking loudly and trying to shorten our game into just six innings. We put up four runs, the final two on two-out, RBI singles from 'Crazy' **Larry Civelli** and **Robbie** "wan Kenobi" **Crider**.

Now we possessed a commanding 19-6 lead and we'd burned up most of that last bit of clock remaining in the game. **Bubba's** had one more shot to score thirteen or more and earn a seventh inning. We held them to one and won the game, 19-7!

When he left I swapped a couple of positions and we kept on playing at a high level without so much as a hiccup in the field. The next time anyone grumbles about EHing, remember this cautionary tale that justifies our rationale for carrying eleven guys every game.

We hit, we fielded and we even ran the bases well against a 5-0 team and walloped them into a first place tie with us. The smell is much nicer upwind of the pack... Great job, **Dirty Dozen**!

Robbie "C.C." **Crider** was 5-5 with three RBI, 'Scary' **Larry Civelli** was 5-5 with two ribs and "Diamond" **Dean Binder** was 2-2 with a walk and four ribbies. "Slim" **Tim McCoy** was 3-4 with an RBI.

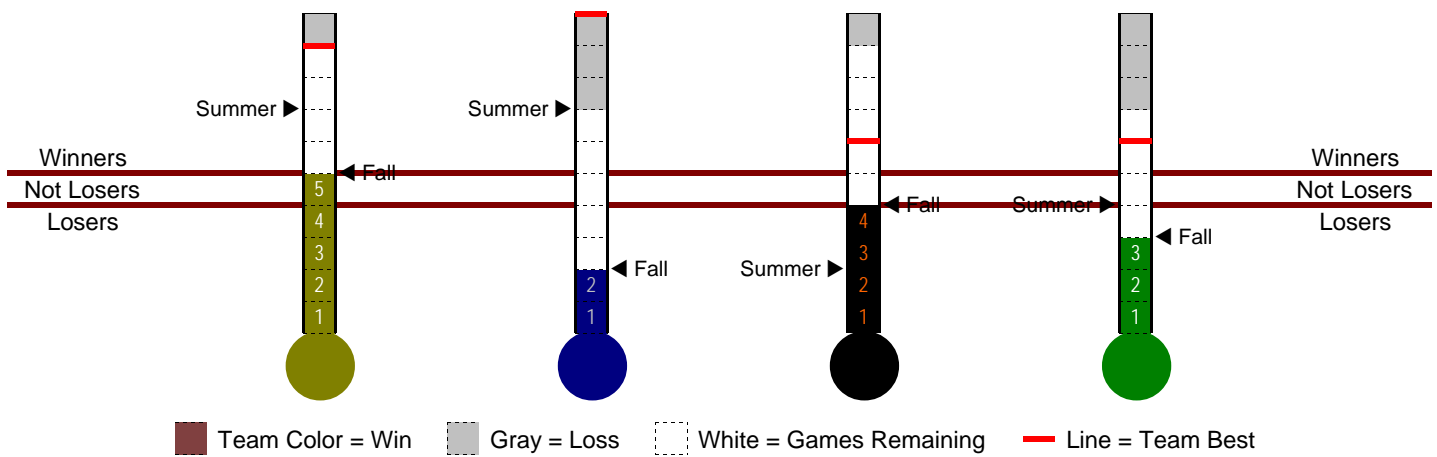

That doesn't matter. They are another good team in our way. We will play them hard and give them their second loss!

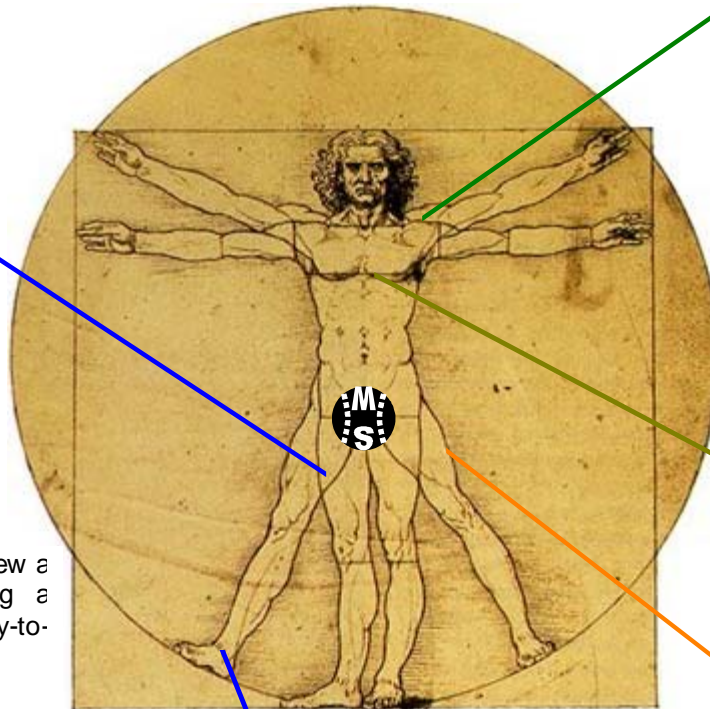

Attached is the first page of the ASA webpage concerning Illegal Softball bats. Make sure your bat has the proper stamp. If you're not sure, check the ASA website.

ASA Bat Testing & Certification Program

The official bat in ASA Championship Play must meet all of the requirements of Rule 3, Section 1 and:

1. must bear **either** the ASA approved 2000 certification mark **or the ASA 2004 certification mark** as shown below, and must not be listed on an ASA non approved list, **or**



2. must be included on a list of approved bat models published by the ASA National Office; or
3. must, in the sole opinion and discretion of the umpire, have been manufactured prior to 2000 and if tested, would comply with the ASA bat performance standards then in effect.

Beginning January 1, 2004, all bats in ASA Championship Play must pass the ASA 2004 bat standard. All bats having the 2004 certification mark will be allowed in ASA Championship Play. Bats that have the 2000 certification mark will not be allowed in ASA Championship Play unless they are listed on an approved bat list on the ASA website. For convenience, the ASA website has a listing of bats that do not pass the ASA 2004 bat standard.

2004 and Beyond Approved Bats (Updated: 12/5/2008)

For a list of bats that have been tested and found to comply with the ASA bat performance standards, and therefore are authorized to bear the **ASA 2004 certification mark** and/or are authorized for use in ASA Championship Play beginning January 1, 2004, please click on the manufacturer below. Manufacturers continue to submit additional bat models for testing, and the ASA will update this list as test results become available.
